

Rosemarie A. Loffredo Appointed Vice President for Financial Operations and Treasurer at New York University

New York, N.Y. — Rosemarie A. Loffredo, an executive with significant financial, business, compliance, and treasury experience, has been named Vice President for Financial Operations and Treasurer at New York University. She joined NYU on October 6 and reports to Martin Dorph, Senior Vice President for Budget and Finance.

The appointment follows NYU's efforts to more closely align its treasurer's and its controller's operations, which led to the creation of a single Division of Financial Operations.

“This search identified a candidate with an optimal set of capabilities required by this new position: a strong financial background; change management skills; and the ability to analyze and reorganize operating structures and improve business processes,” Martin Dorph said. “Rosemarie's background provides an outstanding combination of financial operations, international business, compliance and control, and treasury experience.”

Rosemarie most recently served as Senior Vice President/Finance for CA, Inc. (previously Computer Associates), during which she successfully implemented a global financial and compliance control structure both at the business unit and corporate levels. Previously, she served as Vice President/Treasury for International Paper Company, and has had prior experience in investment banking.

Rosemarie holds a B.S. degree in international economics from Georgetown University, an M.A. in economics from Boston College, and an M.B.A. from Columbia University.
